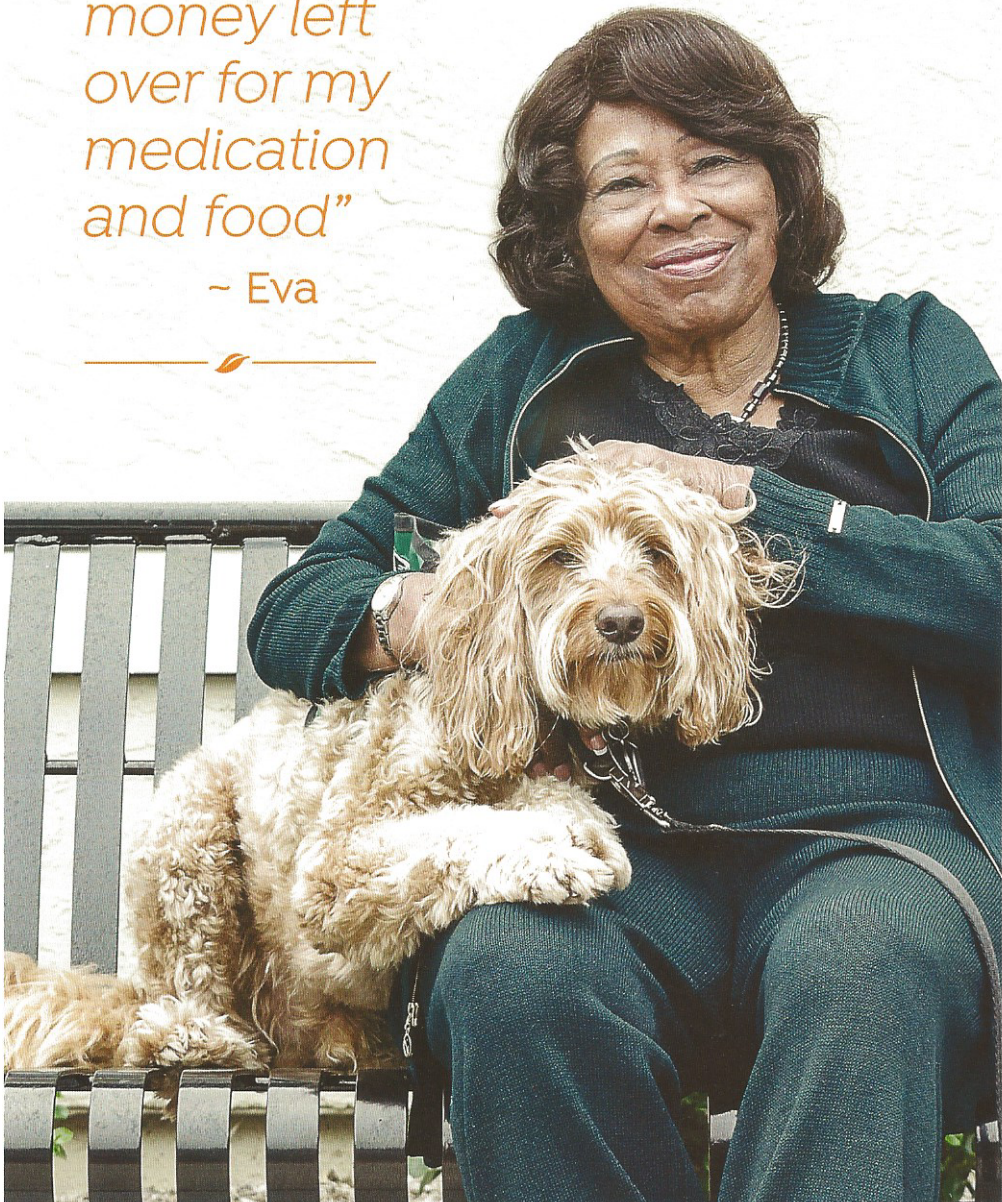

In 1992, Eva became disabled and had to retire early from her job at Hewlett Packard. A few years later, her husband passed away. Eva was grief-stricken – and to make matters worse, she was desperate – she couldn't cover the rent with her income alone. At 62, Eva had to go back to work as a caregiver to make ends meet.

Eva's luck turned when she found Edgewater Isle, an affordable senior community owned by HIP Housing for low-income seniors. Now, at 74, she thrives in a supportive community with 132 other seniors.
